Potters would be given 4 pedestals each for display. Any other property required will have to be managed by the potter,

The Society would charge 20% commission on all Sales for AIFACS Artists Welfare Fund.

The Society will take utmost care in handling the works but not be responsible for any loss or damage during the exhibition and storage period, the potters if they so desire, may insure their works at their cost. Potters are also requested to take back their unsold works on 17th March, 2019 i.e. after the exhibition is over positively, after which the Society will not entertain any claim whatsoever for the works and will be at liberty to dispose off the unsold works as it deems fit.

Potters age should be 25 years and above as on 1.1.2019.

AWARDS:

1. Special Award in the Memory of Late Sardar Gurcharan Singh, eminent ceramic artist and former Treasurer, AIFACS of Rs. 50,000/-
2. One AIFACS Best Cash Award of Rs. 25,000/-
3. Three AIFACS Cash Awards of Rs. 15,000/- each.
4. Three AIFACS Cash Awards of Rs. 10,000/- each.

To encourage more participation, any outstation potter bringing the works by 4 potters will be entitled to get IIIrd A.C. railway fare to and fro but not Rajdhani Train. The Society will not pay any amount for packing or freight, which the participating potters will bear proportionately.

The exhibition will remain open daily between 11 a.m. & 7 p.m. till 16th March, 2019.

It is hoped that you will be extended your cooperation in making this venture of the Society a success. You are requested to inform your co-potters about the details of the exhibition to enable them to participate.
