To All Potters of India

It gives me pleasure to inform you that the AIFACS has decided to hold its 22nd All India Studio Pottery Exhibition in the month of March, 2026 as per details given below:-

Date of Exhibition : 10th to 18th March, 2026

Submission & Display of works by the Potters : 6th & 7th March, 2026

Judging : 9th March, 2026

Inauguration of the Exhibition : 10th March, 2026

Submission of List of works, Personal Photo and soft copy of two of your works in JPEG format for catalogue and Publicity purpose. Latest by 31st January, 2026

Entry fee 500/- by Cash, D.D.or Money Order (D.D. should be in the name of "All India Fine Arts & Crafts Society" payable at New Delhi).

Number of works : Not more than 10 works

(Tea set, Coffee set, Lemon set, Dinner set and Soup bowls would be treated as one exhibit)

Return of Works : 19th March, 2026

Potters would be given 2 pedestals each or one table each for display. Any other property required will have to be managed by the potter.

The Society would charge 20% Commission on all sales for AIFACS Artist Welfare Fund.

The Society will take utmost care in handling the works but not be responsible for any loss or damage during the exhibition and storage period, the potters may insure their works if they so desire at their cost. Potters are also requested to take back their unsold works on 19th March, 2026 i.e. after the exhibition is over positively, after which the Society will not entertain any claim whatsoever for the works and will be at liberty to dispose off the unsold works as it deems fit.

Potters age should be 25 years and above as on 1.1.2026.

AWARDS:

1. One AIFACS cash Award of ? 25,000/- for the best potter of the year.
2. Three AIFACS cash Awards of ? 15,000/- each.
3. Three AIFACS cash Award of ? 10,000/- each.

To encourage more participation, any outstation potter bringing the works by 6 potters will be entitled to get 3rd A.C. railway fare to and fro. The Society will not pay any amount for packing or freight, which the participating potters will bear proportionately.

The exhibition will remain open daily between 11 am to 7 pm till 18th March, 2026.

It is hoped that you will very kindly extend your co-operation in making this venture of the Society a success. You are requested to kindly inform your co-potters about the details of the exhibition to enable them to participate.
